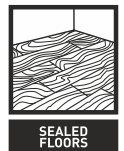

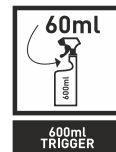
MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH is a quick and simple floor maintainer suitable for use with a mop or rotary polishing machines. **MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH** is suitable for hard floors, sealed wood floors, thermoplastic and synthetic floors. **MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH** can be mopped on neat and will dry to a high gloss or it can be used as a spray buff cleaner.



DILUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS

To use as a spray buff cleaner, dilute 1 part **MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH** to 10 parts water and should be used with a spray cleaning pad. For best results, the machine should be of a medium speed. Alternatively, **MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH** may be mopped onto the floor and allowed to dry, and may be buffed with a suitable rotary machine. Both methods will produce an outstanding finish. **MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH** has a built in cleaning agent and can be damp mopped at a dilution of 1 part **MERLIN F13 MOP & SHINE FLOOR POLISH** to 10 parts water.

N.B. Unsuitable for use on unsealed wood, unsealed cork or laminate flooring.



SAFETY INFORMATION
